

Carefully lift the roof top carrier onto the cross rails and align the mounting holes to the cross rails.

Disengage the side draw latches only. FRONT DRAW LATCHES MUST BE FASTENED AT ALL TIMES WHILE THE CAR TOP CARRIER IS ON THE VEHICLE.

Hold the roof top carrier steady and lift the lid. Pull each lid support bar from the magnet and rotate down to the receiving area.



Step ladders may be needed for taller vehicles




Insert each support bar into the receiving area.


Add 1 spacer to each U-bolt. Add 2nd spacer to each U-bolt if cross rails are less than 3/4" tall.

Insert the U-bolts with spacers into the mounting holes from below the cross rails.


Install the remaining mounting hardware as shown. Do not tighten completely until step 8.



Ensure the roof top carrier is centered on the cross rails, then tighten the wing nuts and cover the ends of the U-bolt with the caps.





9 Ensure the roof top carrier is securely fastened to the cross rails. Evenly distribute luggage and gear within the roof top carrier.



The roof top carrier is weather resistant only. Protect items accordingly from water and dust.

Rotate lid support bars into position against magnets and lower the lid. Insert key into lock, rotate horizontal and remove key. Fasten all side draw latches.
